Jørgen Kastholm

The Danish designer Jørgen Kastholm created furniture where form, function and finish comes together beautifully. He designed furniture that today is an intrinsic part of Danish design DNA.

Kastholm first trained as a blacksmith, and later went to study architecture at the School of Interior Design in Copenhagen under Finn Juhl. It is his partnership with the designer Preben Fabricius that propelled him to international fame. Kastholm was appointed professor at Bergische University in Wuppertal where he taught design from 1975 to

1996. He continued his work in Germany as well as in his house in Mallorca. Kastholm was until his death in 2007 very active and had a successful career where he received a number of design prizes and awards in recognition of some of his more prominent work.
